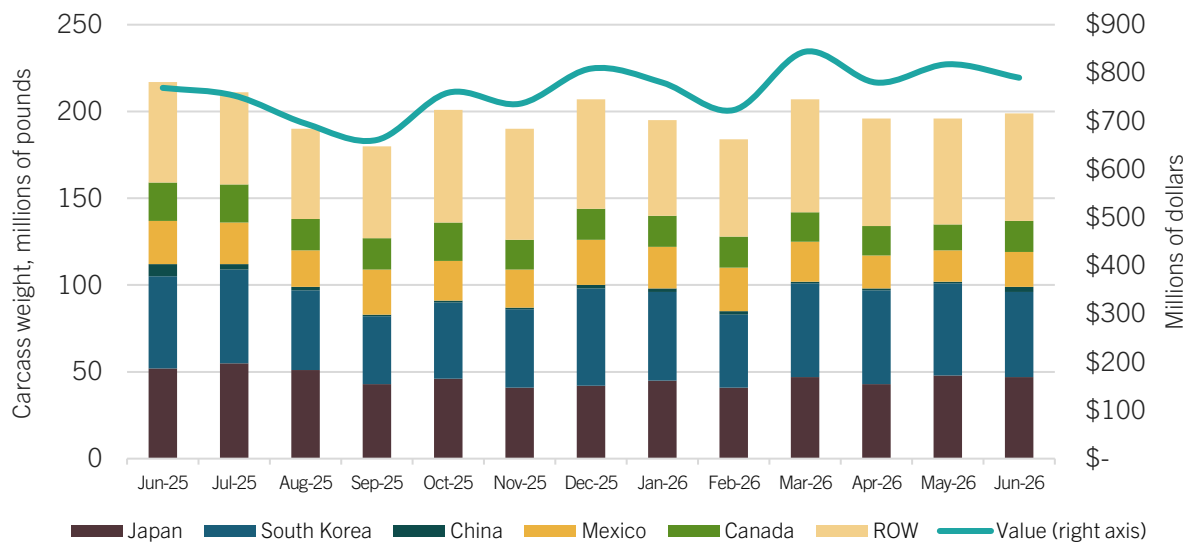


Monthly beef exports and imports

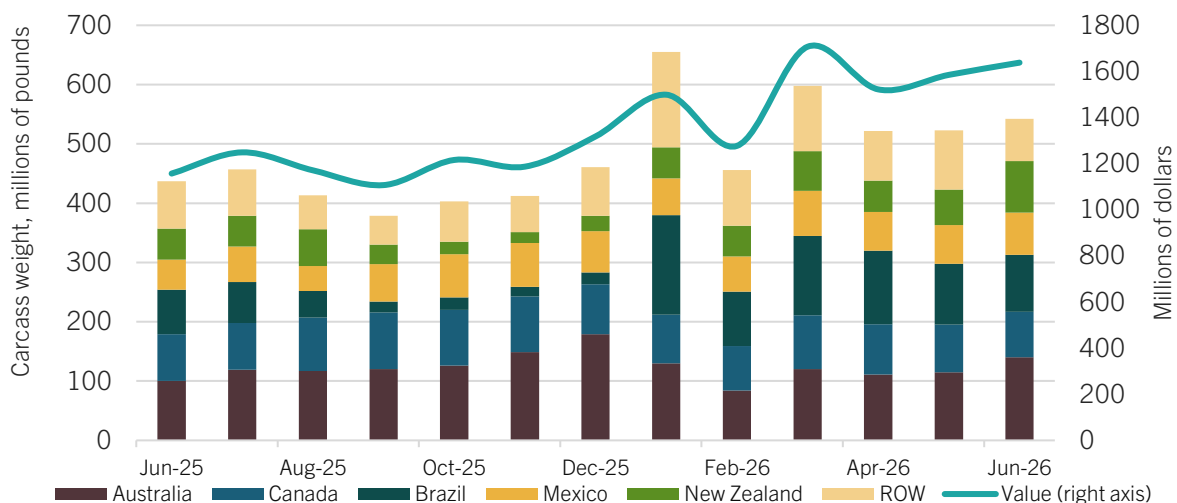
The charts below highlight the latest monthly trade flow data for the top five trading partners and the rest of the world. In 2025, the U.S. exported \$9.3 billion worth of beef and beef products, a 10.8% reduction year over year. Exports to China have continued to drop significantly, declining more than 90% compared to the previous year. Meanwhile, imports surged. The shrinking U.S. cattle herd is increasing the need for imported beef to blend with domestic supplies to meet demand.
